Hi,

Welcome to Kaze Chikara Karate Club, a non-profit, voluntary organisation, where we study the art of Shotokan Karate together. We are affiliated to the Karate Union of Great Britain (KUGB), the largest Shotokan Karate organisation in Britain. More information about the club, including our constitution and policies, is available at our website, <https://www.kaze.org.uk/>. Contact information and links to our social media are also available there.

After around 4 lessons, you should apply for a KUGB licence, using the online system at <https://kugb.me>. On first application, you will receive your licence and grading record book, which allows you to attend many competitions and training courses around the country, and progress through the grades.

As we train in the community centre, after about 4 weeks, each individual must become a member of the Community Association. This is for the Community Associations insurance, and the fees help with the upkeep of the centre. **The Club will pay the fees on your behalf**, but please complete the form provided. This membership allows you to attend any of the other groups using the centre, and allows you to book a room - e.g. for a children's party.

From 16th May 2022, the class times will be as follows:

5.15pm until 6pm: Children's class. This class will maintain the general structure of a karate class, but is aimed at younger children, combining karate technical instruction with games and general fitness.

6pm until 7.30pm: All grades class. This class will cover all aspects of karate for beginners to 4th Kyu (purple belt with white stripe). Seniors are expected to train, and will be included, but the main focus will be the juniors and intermediates.

7.30pm until 8.15pm: Advanced class. This class is mainly for seniors, covering the senior syllabus and advanced kata and kumite for competition. Lower grades are welcome to stay, but the main focus will be the seniors.

Also from 16th May 2022, prices for classes will change. To attend just the children's class will cost £3, with attendance of either the all grades class, the advanced class, or both, costing £5.

Payments can be made on the night in cash, or by PayPal using the account <https://paypal.me/kazechikara>. Further payment options, with pricing incentives, are being explored, such as direct online credit card payments for multiple classes, and monthly direct debit subscriptions. These will be announced on the website and facebook group as they become available.

Finally, it is important that the club has contact details for everyone, in case of short notice changes, and an emergency contact number in the unlikely event of an injury during class. These can be supplied using the secure form on the website at <https://www.kaze.org.uk/contact>. Alternatively, you can use the form on the back of this letter and return it to me.
